Listening and Speaking: Forms and expresses ideas on a range of topics.

Written

Purposes and audiences: Recognise how to shape texts for a purpose and an audience. Self-Reports, Recounts, Descriptions
Language features: Use language features, showing some recognition of their effects - Conventions: capital letter, full stops and word order: volume and clarity: and simple symbols

Reading

Personal Reading – Selecting and reading independently for enjoyment and information. - **Instructional Reading – Guided reading** structured to cater to specific learning needs.
Shared Reading – Teacher/student reading. Reading for information. Reading for language features and structures.
Developing reading comprehension. Skills; discussing genres, structures, language features, meanings & ideas in a range of text (as per writing/topic focus).
