No Compulsory Science Fair this year

As we now cover Science as a regular part of our classroom programme with both Mr Finnigan and at Rongotai, we have decided to move away from completing a Science Fair as a compulsory part of our programme and instead take this opportunity to study Ancient Civilisations. The Science Fair can be completed as a Steeple Rock Challenge, and the opportunity to go to the NIWA Regional Science Fair will still be available. If your child would like to take part in this, please email their teacher.

Ancient Civilisations: During this inquiry, we will explore day-to-day life, research innovations, and examine the rise and fall of empires from around the world. Ancient Rome, Greece, and Egypt will be among the civilisations studied, as will a range of others. If your child enjoys this topic, a research project could be a great Steeple Rock challenge to share with their classmates!

Homelearning

Reminder:

- 1. Reading: at least 20 mins 4 nights a week.
- 2. Complete 5 challenges by the end of the year, with a minimum expectation of 1 per term.
- 3. The final element of the home learning programme will be an individual study of an Ancient Civilisation, which will need to be completed and presented by the end of the term. More information on this project will be sent out via Hero over the course of the next week.
